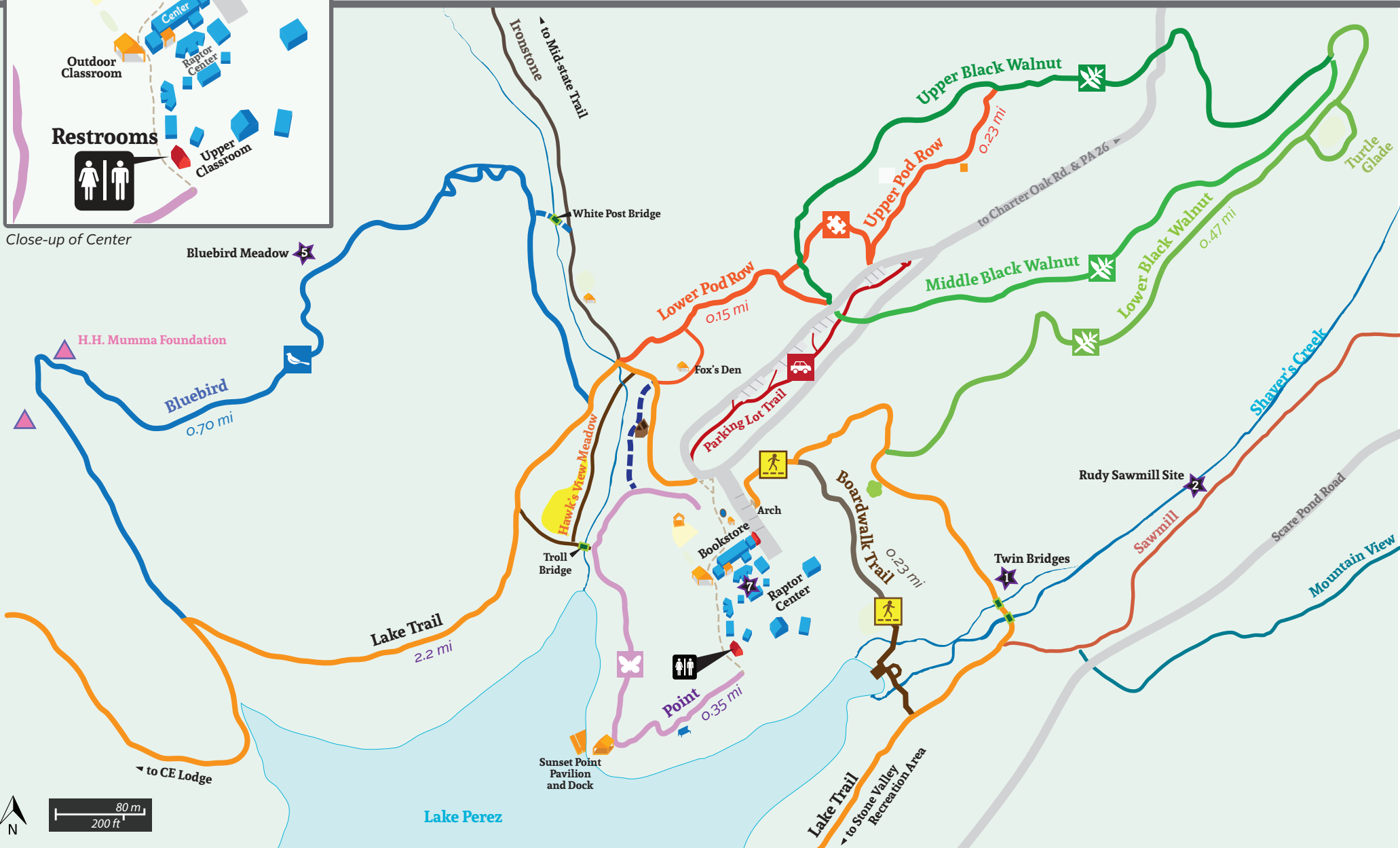

There is a small recycling and composting station in the main building of Shaver's Creek. We strive to send no trash to the landfill!



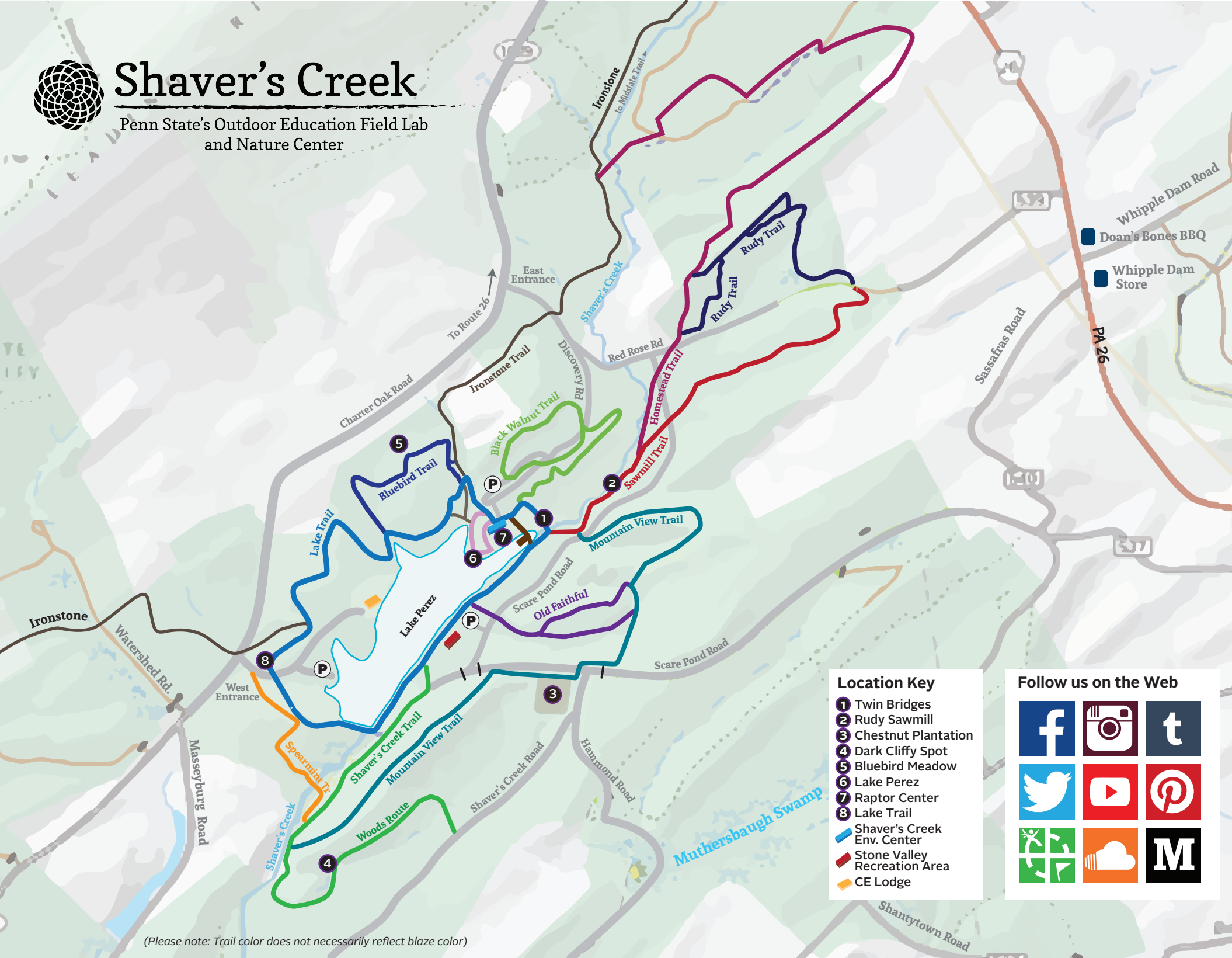
