

Musser Gap Greenway

The Musser Gap Greenway is a 355-acre tract that is open to the public and serves as a non-motorized connection to Rothrock State Forest for the State College area, making the vast natural and recreational resources of the forest more accessible for residents and visitors alike.

In 2018, Penn State began the process of transforming the Greenway into a place where the stewardship of our natural resources and the enhancement of recreational opportunities promotes a deeper connection to nature and an appreciation for the Centre Region landscape.
